- A cleaning charge for all manual and hydraulic Unit(s) will be in effect when applicable.

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FUSION EQUIPMENT TRAINING

Operational equipment training, if requested or required, will be made available as schedules permit at a designated fee per person Monday through Friday. Weekend or "layover" rate is 1 1/2 times the per person rate. Additional expenses (mileage, lodging, food, airfare, car rental and fees) will be prepaid and invoiced when applicable. *McElroy Certified Operator Qualification training is also available upon request, contact the Equipment Services Department for details.*

RENTAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OVERVIEW

The following Terms and Conditions Overview applies to all rental equipment and is subject to the Industrial Sales Rental Agreement within the Rental Order document on the reverse side thereof, and the terms of any Account Agreement, Personal Guaranty, Account Statements and related documents between Industrial Sales and the Renter and are incorporated herein by reference.

1. A signed Rental Order/Rental Agreement and an approved Industrial Sales Account Agreement must be in place or a predetermined deposit equal to the cost of the Unit(s) and a "Certificate of Insurance" providing liability, comprehensive and workman's compensation coverage designating Industrial Sales as additional insured may be required.
2. Renter acknowledges that the Unit(s) is of a size, design, capacity and Manufacturer selected by the Renter, and accepts receipt of the Unit(s) and any additional accessories required. Industrial Sales along with the Manufacturer accepts no responsibility or liability for the operation and maintenance of the Unit(s). The Renter agrees that Industrial Sales or the Manufacturer shall not be liable to Renter and Renter shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend Industrial Sales and the Manufacturer from any and all liability, loss, damage, and expense, causes of action suits, claims, or judgments directly or indirectly from rental of the Unit(s) or other services provided.
3. Industrial Sales, at its option and at a predetermined fee, will furnish technical advice and/or training in reference to the use of the Unit(s) by Renter; it being expressly understood that Industrial Sales and the Manufacturer assume no obligation or liability for the technical advice and/or training provided. Industrial Sales and the Manufacturer recommend that the pipe manufacturer's or the Plastic Pipe Institute's standard joining procedures be followed when using the Unit(s) (refer to the most current joining procedures for additional information and clarifications).
4. The Unit(s) rents every day, excluding Sundays and Nationally Recognized Holidays as observed by Industrial Sales. Weekly rental is based on 7 consecutive work days. Monthly rental is based on 30 consecutive work days. Rental charges are calculated from the date of departure to the date of return and are adjusted accordingly for any exclusions if applicable. The Unit(s) must be returned by 12:00 noon in clean condition and in proper working order or any additional rental expense, repairs and cleaning charges will apply.
5. All Units are F.O.B. ship point, and freight to and from destination is to be paid by Renter. Notification of completion of rental usage, return and transit are the responsibility of Renter, and all rental continue until the Unit(s) is in the possession of Industrial Sales. Loss or damage of the Unit(s) while in transit shall be the responsibility of the Renter except when delivered and returned by Industrial Sales personnel or an authorized agent.
6. Industrial Sales shall have the right of inspection of the Unit(s) during regular business hours wherever said Unit(s) is located. On a long term rental (30 days or more) the Renter will allow and make arrangements for Industrial Sales to inspect the Unit(s) on site or at an Industrial Sales service center, and in either case the cost of inspection will be incurred by the Renter.

Note: "Chargeable Items" are those items that are not deemed as ordinary wear within the Unit(s) rental use and are classified as unrepairable to include missing ground plugs, male plug ends or damaged cords; scratched, nicked or gouged heater adapters; and any other items unlisted that are determined to be unrepairable. Repair parts will be based on the Unit(s) model with a minimum labor charge of one half (1/2) hour plus parts, and any additional Unit(s) repairs will be evaluated and invoiced at Renter's expense based on the current parts pricing and hourly labor rate in effect.



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
